Monday: Return to Home Ports or beyond

Mooring Arrangements:

[The](#) cove east of Drum Point provides excellent holding ground. Pending weather, we plan to raft with PRIM centering the main raft. Please be prepared to break away and anchor if conditions require. There is more than enough room in the cove for anchoring clear of others. Approaching the main raft, call on VHF Ch 74 for instructions (please use Low Power transmission when appropriate).

Radio Watch Plan: Channel 74, “WRSC Cruising Fleet”

Monitor and use VHF Channel 74 at 15 minutes past each odd numbered hour. The radio watch will begin at 11:15 A.M. and terminate after the 5:15 P.M. watch period on Saturday. s/v PRIM will monitor 9, 16 and 74 continuously .
