## Notice Of Event — Spring Rendezvous

June 13-14, 2009 – Destination Mill Creek

### General Description:

The WRSC Cruising Fleet will hold an informal race from the end of Pirates' Cove dock to Hackett Can (C "1") at the mouth of Whitehall Bay. After the finish, we'll anchor in Mill Creek and have dinner at Cantler's Riverside Inn. Sunday is cruise-back day.

### Location:

Start off the end of Pirates' Cove Pier at 1100.

### Activities:

This is a combined event for the Big Boat Racing and Cruising fleets over the weekend of June 13 & 14. We're heading to Whitehall Bay and Mill Creek. The race will start from the end of Pirates Cove pier at 11:00 A.M. on Saturday, and finish between the finish boat, Mason 44 Buloha, and Hackett Can, C "1". If we drag anchor again to the point where your boat doesn't *fit* between Buloha and C "1", sail close by and make sure we know you're there. We encourage everybody to participate in the racing but don't miss this event just because you don't care to compete. It'll still be a nice cruise. Our anchorage in Mill Creek will be about 14 miles from Hargte's so it is a good event for all sizes of boats. For the last few years we've had really nice wind – well, really a *lot* of wind - but be prepared for anything or nothing.

After the race, head up Mill Creek to the cove just upstream from Cantler's, or wait and follow Buloha, the 6.5-ft-draft finish boat. The water doesn't get to less than 8 feet in the "s" turn at the entrance to Mill Creek. We'll try to post "advice" on entering the creek on the web site ahead of time.

Around 6, head over to Cantler's for dinner, either in your dinghies, or via land by bringing your dinghy into the Romarys' pier and walking from there. It takes a while to get a table for 20 to 30 people, but it's worth the wait.

Sunday, enjoy a leisurely breakfast on your boat before cruising back home.

VHF Channel 74 at 15 minutes past each odd numbered hour beginning at 1115 on 14 June and ending after all participants have finished the race, or arrived near Whitehall Bay.
