## BOAT PARKING APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, request parking and/or dinghy rack parking for the boats(s) designated on the reverse. For the privilege of parking my boat(s) on West River Sailing Club grounds from March 1, 2010 to February 28, 2011, I submit herewith payment and proof of liability insurance for each one design trailer/dolly parking space requested and for each dinghy rack space requested. I understand that I will receive a refund of any payment I have made for which no space is allocated.

I agree to the following:

- That I will keep my boat(s), trailer(s)/dolly(s) and boat cover(s) neat and orderly so as to present a good appearance and that I will maintain the licensed, road-worthy trailer/vehicle listed below for the removal of my boat from Club grounds
- That whenever my boat is in an assigned parking space it shall be kept on a licensed road-worthy trailer, or, in the event the licensed vehicle is kept elsewhere, on a dolly; and that I will not use my assigned space or the Club grounds to do major construction or repairs to my boat(s) or trailer(s)
- To abide by such additional regulations as may be promulgated by WRSC regarding my use of the assigned space
- That WRSC shall not be liable for the loss of, or damage to, said boat(s) or trailer(s)/dolly(s) described below whether such damage or loss is caused by fire, theft, vandalism, or acts of the agents or employees of the WRSC, or any other cause
- To display my annual parking sticker on the tongue of my trailer/dolly within 21 days of issuance
- To notify WRSC if my boat/trailer/dolly will be off club grounds for a period of 60 days or more and will give WRSC permission to use my space during this period
- To give WRSC a minimum of 15 days notice as to when my boat/trailer/dolly will return to WRSC
- Not to store more than two boats, owned by me, in my assigned space
- To inform the boat parking chair if I need to store a different boat from what my assigned space has registered. I understand that if the alternate boat is wider than the one on this agreement, I may be charged an additional fee. To provide additional proof of liability insurance for this change of boat.
- If a club member w/ a boat parking spot transfers his or her boat to another club member, the new owner may retain the spot upon providing proof of insurance and a \$50 transfer fee.
- The club will not extend storage privileges to member-owned, motor-powered vessels.

I accept the rules and procedures adopted by the WRSC Executive Board from time to time for evaluating my participation in WRSC programs and activities as the basis for allocating available boat parking. (*See WRSC By-Laws for Boat Parking Criteria and Obligations*). In the event that I leave my boat(s) and trailer(s)/dolly(s) on WRSC property without authorization or if I do not remove my boat(s) and/or trailer(s)/dolly(s) from the property within thirty (30) days after this agreement expires or if I otherwise break this agreement WRSC may remove my boat(s) and/or trailer(s)/dolly(s) at my expense and reclaim my assigned space. I further agree to pay a storage charge of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) a month to WRSC and to reimburse WRSC for all fees, including attorney's fees incurred in enforcing this agreement or acquiring title to my boat(s) and/or trailer(s)/dolly(s) in the event my boat(s) and or trailer(s)/dolly(s) become abandoned.

### Agreement and Declaration

I am applying for boat parking pursuant to Boat Parking Criterion # \_\_\_\_\_. I understand that this agreement and declaration is a term of the parking contract.

- Criterion 5. Boat of a WRSC sanctioned class member
- Criterion 6. Boat of a WRSC sanctioned class or a provisional sanctioned class member who does not indicate an intention of being an active racer.
- Criterion 7. Boat of a WRSC non-sanctioned class member.
