**Notice of Cruise – Labor Day Weekend at Dun Cove and Oxford
September 4-6, 2010**

General Description:

This year's Labor Day cruise will be at a different venue. The cruising committee decided to hold this cruise closer to home in the hope that the cruisers who are helping with the regatta early in the weekend at the clubhouse can join us either in Dun Cove or Oxford.

On September 4, we plan to have a raft in Dun Cove, off the Choptank River just north of Knapps Narrows. Sea Eagle will serve as the anchor boat. Weather conditions will dictate the duration of the raft. There is adequate space in the Cove for those who desire to anchor separately. For those of you who have not been through the narrows and who are not depth challenged, we recommend this route to get to Dun Cove. Otherwise travel around Blackwalnut Point to enter the Choptank River and head north to Dun Cove. We will gather for happy hour and our traditional shared appetizers on board Sea Eagle at 1700 hours.

On Sunday, September 5, we'll take a short sail to Oxford and Mears Yacht Haven. For those who plan to come to Mears Yacht Haven, reservations should be made as soon as possible. The marina is holding some slips for us and you need to make your own arrangements with the marina. Call 410-226-5450. A credit card number will hold your reservation. Reservations may be canceled, without penalty, prior to 9:00 a.m. on the day preceding the arrival day. We will have a short happy hour on Sunday and for those interested we will go to dinner at Schooners Landing, located is a short distance from the marina. The marina has a swimming pool so make sure you bring your swimming suit.
